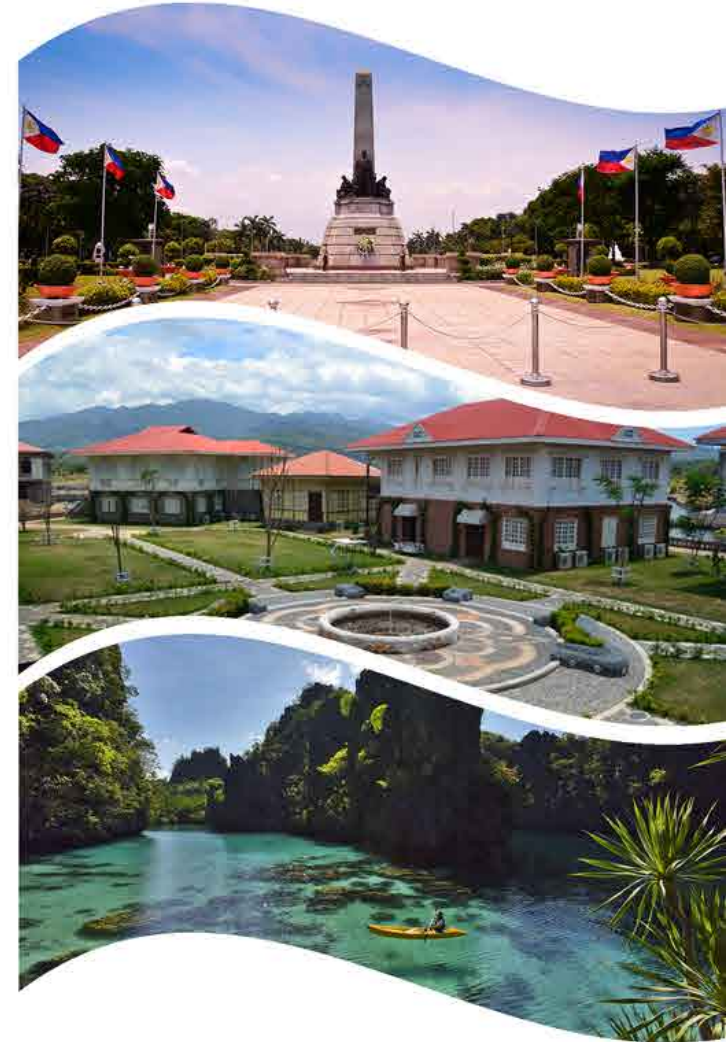

DAY 3 - 16 JULY 2019, TUESDAY

Early morning departure for Bataan Peninsula Tour

The tour proceeds to Kilometer Marker Zero and continue north with stops at various Death March markers as we follow the route of the Death March. To be visited also are the sites of Field Hospitals #1 and #2, and Angels of Bataan Marker at Limay, which commemorates the contribution of the nurses during the Battles of Bataan and Corregidor. After lunch, proceed to Mt. Samat. One of the most important shrines built to remember the bravery and sacrifices of American and Filipino soldiers who fought during the war. Located in Pilar, Bataan, the park was built in 1966 in commemoration of the 25th anniversary of World War II. The shrine is marked by the enormous Memorial Cross and contains a museum and various monuments highlighting the events of the Battle of Bataan. Tour continues with a visit to the Balanga Elementary School, the site where Gen. Ernest King surrendered the USAFFE forces in Bataan to Gen. Masaharu Homma after months of fierce combat.

Rolling Tour of Clark Freeport Zone

Once known as Clark Air Base, the site was one of the major bases of the United States in Asia from 1903 to 1991. The area covers roughly 14 square miles and played important roles during World War II and the Vietnam War. Upon arrival, view the Fort Stotsenberg gates which marked the original entrance to the base. The tour then proceeds to the Parade Ground, the Civilian Cemetery and the Clark Field Museum
