## ITINERARY

### DAY 1: JULY 21, SUNDAY

- Arrive Manila
- Transfer to hotel
- Check-in
- Overnight stay at Holiday Inn Express Manila

### DAY 2: JULY 22, MONDAY

- Breakfast
- Check-out
- Transfer to airport
- Depart to Cebu
- Arrive Cebu
- Proceed Cebu City Tour with lunch

Rediscover Cebu City, the oldest city of the Philippines and sample its rich culture reminiscent of the Spanish and Chinese influence. Drive through the scenic Beverly Hills where the impressive Taoist Temple lords over the whole mountain side, then visit Fort San Pedro, the smallest and oldest tri-bastion fort in the country. Rediscover the Magellan's Cross and the site where the Portuguese explorer, Ferdinand Magellan, planted a cross in 1521, on the very spot where the first Filipinos were baptized. Relive the religious fervor of the early Christian Filipinos at the Basilica Minore del Sto. Niño which houses the image of Sto. Niño, the oldest Spanish religious relic in the Philippines and Cebu's patron saint. Then, experience Cebu's past colonial lifestyle through the splendor of Casa Gorordo Museum, once the residence of the first Filipino Bishop of Cebu.

### DAY 3: JULY 23, TUESDAY

- Breakfast
- Proceed Island Hopping Tour with lunch

The adventure begins at 9:00AM when your tour guide escorts you to board the outrigger canoe from designated jetty. Cruise along the waters of the Mactan Channel and swing around Nalusuan, Sulpa, and Hilutungan Islands. Drop anchor at Hilutungan Island for swimming, snorkeling, fish feeding and enjoys Cebu's underwater attraction before moving on for a delicious picnic lunch at Nalusuan Island.

- Overnight stay at Seda Ayala Cebu

### DAY 4: JULY 24, WEDNESDAY

- Proceed Bohol Day Tour

This is a full day tour to the scenic countryside of Bohol, a showcase of history, culture and nature in one destination. Visit the Blood Compact Shrine, view of the Spanish Architectural Design of the centuries-old church in Loboc and Baclayon. Proceed to mystical beauty of the 1,277-cone shaped Carcar Chocolate Hills in Carmen, passing through the Mahogany Man - made Bilar Forest. Take a glimpse of the small cottage industries in Loay.

En route back, take a one (01) hour river cruise with lunch on a floating restaurant. After the cruise proceed to see the oldest living mammal and the smallest primate - the TARSIERS, recorded in GUINNESS BOOK OF RECORDS.

Shop for native products and delicacies then afterwards, depart from Tagbilaran (Bohol) for Cebu.
